- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses for the AA degree in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.
- This program can be completed either in Capital's traditional day undergraduate program or in the evening adult degree completion program.

- Students in this major are encouraged to pursue a double major outside of business or a minor in a business or non-business discipline. Students should work with their Capital advisors to determine which program is a good fit for the student's long term goals and transfer course work.
- Students must complete 12 credit hours of upper level business course work (300 level or higher) at Capital and must complete at least 9 hours of elective credit outside of the Business department. To receive a degree from Capital, you must complete 30 of your last 36 credit hours at Capital. A total of 124 credit hours with a 2.0 cumulative GPA is required to receive the Bachelor of Arts degree. A foreign language is not required for this degree.
