**\* Special Admission Requirements**

Prior to admission to this major, students may declare a pre-major at the time of university admission or soon thereafter. After declaring a pre-major, apply for admission into the BSW program. Applicants are selected by the Social Work faculty based on academic and professional promise. Students may apply to the program while in the process of completing the list of requirements, however, full admission requires completion of: (1) 30 hours of course work with a 2.50 or above overall GPA; (2) FSW 201 (CS MHAD 1111) with a grade of C or better and passing BIO 161 (CS BIO 2232), ECO 201 (CS ECON 220), SOC 151 (CS SOC 1101), and PSY 111(CS PSY 1100); (3) 20 hours of volunteer work in a social service agency within the past four years; (4) a questionnaire; and (5) two recommendations. Social Work applications are available on the FSW website and in Room 101 McGuffey Hall. Application packets must be filed in the Social Work Program Office by **March 31**. Admission is limited. All students, regardless of year of entry, are held to the Social Work Retention Policy.
