- **CSCC General Education Requirements:** Students should choose the General Education courses for the AS in consultation with their academic and faculty advisors.

- All programs in the College of Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences leading to a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture require a minimum of 121 semester hours, including a minimum of 12 hours in the major from the academic unit offering the major at OSU. A student needs to complete two global issues courses in the GE. Select the Literature, Art, Culture and Ideas, and Historical Study courses carefully.
